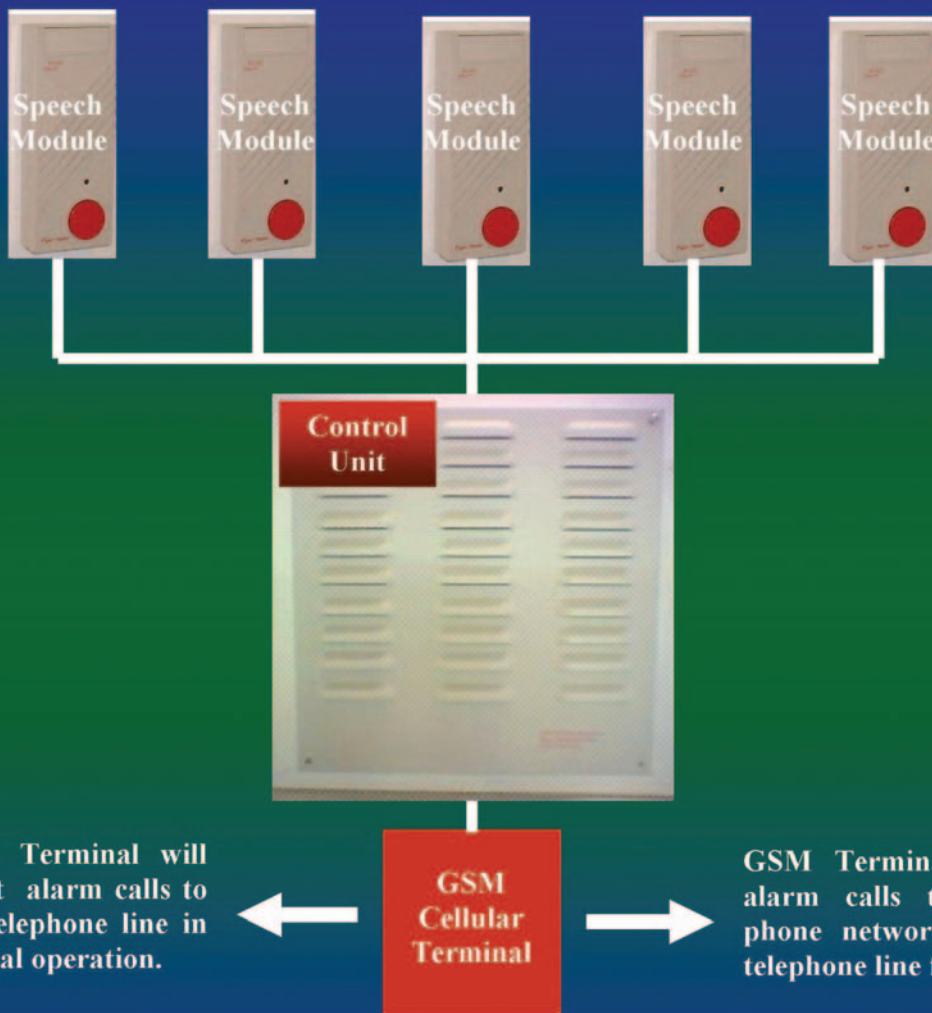

PRODUCT FEATURES

The GSM module automatically dials using a telephone line when available but uses the mobile phone network as a backup.

The GSM module does not need a telephone line and is simply plugged into the mains supply, and a dispersed alarm fitted.

Standard dispersed alarms can be used with the GSM module with no additional programming.

The GSM can be used with other telecom systems as a backup to landline communication.

The GSM module is available with or without battery backup to suit individual circumstances.

The unit is easy to program with no need for specialist training or expertise.

The unit cost is less than the price of many standard dispersed alarms.

Dual frequency operation over 900MHz and 1800MHz bands.

USER BENEFITS

This means that calls can be made by the most cost-effective method even if the telephone line develops a fault.

An alarm can be quickly fitted even where no telephone line is available.

This means that an alarm can be provided promptly from the landlord's stock for only the price of the GSM module.
